The drumming assembly is on Friday, 23 June at 2.45pm and the keyboards will be performing on Tuesday 27 June at 2.45pm. We look forward to seeing you there. Due to the performance, drumming lessons will move to Thursday 22 June for this week only.

Lunchboxes - please could we remind parents to provide a healthy balanced lunch for their children, as too much chocolate and crisps does not help them to focus throughout the afternoon.

School Dinner Money - we would like to give parents advance notice that the cost of school dinners will be rising in September to £2.30 per day. As ever, payments for dinners, etc must be made in advance, either on the day or weekly/monthly/termly. This will generate a new one so that you can continue to make payments online. You will also be able to see what your balance is, see which meal your child has picked each day as well as make payments for trips, clubs and music lessons.

Sports Days - Nursery and Reception will be holding their sports day on 21 June 9.30-11.30am. The weather is expected to get cooler by then, but please ensure that your child has a sun hat and water bottle with them and apply sun cream before coming to school. Year 1 and 2 will be on 5 July 1.30-3pm. Years 3, 4 and 5 will be 5 July from 9.30am until 12pm. Year 6 are having their own sports day on 27 June 9-10am. If the weather causes us to cancel we will text parents to let you know. Please assume that sports day will go ahead unless you receive a text.

After School Club - We will be offering an after school club from September for children from Nursery up to Year 6. It will be open daily from 3.15-6pm. The costs will vary depending on how long you would like your child/ren to stay. From 3.15-4.30pm the cost will be £4.50 for each child. If you would like to use the club until 6pm then the cost will be £7 per child (with any other siblings costing £6.50 if they are also attending on the same day). Further information will be sent out shortly. As we will have an after school club on site, we will no longer operate the walking bus.

Parking - Could we ask parents who have permits to use our staff car park to please park within the allocated spaces if there are any available, as cars are being damaged when the car park gets overcrowded. Parents without permits should not be in the staff car park.
