News

Widemouth Bay Residential - a reminder to parents of Year 5 children who are due to go on the trip, that the balance must please be paid in full by Friday 26 May, when we break up for half term.

Lateness - the number of children arriving just a few minutes late is on the rise. The cloakroom doors open at 8.45am and all children should be on site by then. Registers are taken between 8.50 and 9am. Anyone arriving after this time will be marked in as late. If children arrive after 9.15am then they receive an unauthorised late mark. Please try to ensure that being late into school only happens on very rare occasions and does not occur regularly.

Healthy snacks - Just a polite reminder that it is school policy that children have healthy snacks on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Children in EYFS and KS1 are provided with free fruit by the Government. Water bottles should contain water if the children would like a drink during lessons.

School Uniform - A huge thank you to all children who come to school looking smart in our correct school uniform. Children should be wearing grey/black trousers or navy skirt, light blue polo shirt and our school sweatshirt/navy cardigan. Shoes should be black/dark blue. The heel height of shoes should be reasonable and

appropriate for wearing all day. We encourage the children to wear flat shoes so they can run around and play safely. If staff notice that your child has a heel that is high or that they are struggling to wear their shoes all day, they will contact you. From September our uniform policy will state that shoes should be flat. This will be in line with THS uniform policy.

School Show - All choir members in the performance of 'Pirates of the Curry Bean' will require plain black tops and either their school trousers/skirts or plain black leggings/trousers. The approximate running length of the show is 1 hour 15 minutes. Therefore for the evening performance, children should be collected from outside the Year 3 classroom doors at 6.50pm.

Photo Orders - a reminder that orders for the class photos must be in by tomorrow. Late orders can be posted direct to Tempest (address on the order form), but you will need to add £4 to your payment.

Dance and Drama - These clubs will start again after half term. Dance will be on a Monday 3.15-4pm and drama on a Friday (same time). If your child is interested, please pick up a form from the office.
