

Year 5: On Friday 5<sup>th</sup> February two local fire prevention officers came to chat to the children in year 5 about fire prevention. The children were involved in a role-play showing how to make a 999 call, learnt different ways to prevent fires and keep themselves safe, and discussed what to do in the event of a fire. The children learnt to STOP, DROP and ROLL if their clothes were to ignite and to GET OUT, STAY OUT and call 999 in the event of a fire. Some children had the chance to race to get dressed into fire clothing. Since the visit the fire prevention officers have recommended that ALL children learn their address (including the postcode) and ensure that they have discussed an escape route for their own houses. They asked children to all test their home smoke alarms. The children had a lot of fun asking questions and learning during the session.
