What should you do if a student tests positive for Coronavirus after the end of term?

Term will officially end on Wednesday 16th December, but new guidelines set by the Government mean that school staff will be available beyond this date to support pupils and parents/carers in relation to contact tracing after a positive Coronavirus test result.

If a pupil tests positive for Coronavirus having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school (i.e. on or before 18th December) we can assist in identifying close contacts and advising them to self-isolate. This is because the individual may have been infectious while in school. We can also support a staff member who tests positive in this way, and therefore will ensure any pupils or staff who were close contacts are informed.

Please email us on attendance@heathcoat.devon.sch.uk and we will call you back. Members of the leadership team will be checking this email address for the first 6 days of the holiday. It will be checked in the morning, at lunchtime and in the afternoon.

School staff will be on-call to support you with contact tracing for 6 days after the final day of teaching i.e. up to and including Tuesday 22nd December. **This is because we recognise that it may take longer than the 48 hours after school has closed to get tested and receive your result.**
