

Privacy Notice: Visitors

This privacy notice lets you know what happens to any personal data that you give the School when you sign-in as a visitor to the School, and how the School complies with GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations) and the Data protection Act 2018.

What we collect

We may collect the following personal data as part of the process of signing in as a visitor:

Full Name & Contact Number
Purpose of Visit and/or who you are visiting
Date and Times
Registration Number

Why we collect

This data is collected in order to accurately track visitors to the School as part of our legal obligation to comply with Safeguarding and the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 (HSWA).

Your details may be used to contact you in the event of an emergency, or if you are unaccounted for, or to support NHS test & trace following an outbreak of Covid-19. This data will only be used on the day of your visit.

The School will not use this data for any other purposes.

Who do we share this information with?

This data is not routinely shared with any external parties, but may be shared with emergency services or local public health teams in the case of an incident at the School.

How long do we store this information for?

This data will be kept for + 6 years, and then will be destroyed. Track & trace data is stored for 21 days and then destroyed.

Who has access to the information?

The School will ensure that suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures are in place to safeguard and secure the data we collect and to ensure that only staff with an operational need have access.

Your rights

As a visitor (data subject) you have the following rights:

Right of access

You have the right to request to see a copy of the data we hold about you

Right to rectification

You have the right to request corrections to the data we hold about you if it is incorrect

You have the right to lodge a complaint against the School regarding data protection issues with the Information Commissioners Office (ICO) (<https://ico.org.uk/concerns>)
