On Thursday, 19th May 2022

Is your child in Reception, Years 1 and 2 or entitled to free school meals in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6? If so, please can you help by ensuring that your child has a school dinner on Thursday, 19th May 2022.

This is the day when the School Census is taken and if all of our children have the meals they are entitled to, the school will be given the money required to offer free school meals to all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils and those pupils entitled to free school meals in Key Stage 2. If children do not take up their provision on Thursday, 19th May, but have meals throughout the rest of the year, the cost has to come from the school's general budget which means there is less money to spend on teaching and learning. You will be aware from the media of increasing financial pressures on schools and at Heathcoat Primary School we would like to spend all of our money on the children's education.

If you feel that you can help us in achieving this and your child is in Reception, Years 1 and 2 or entitled to free school meals in Years 3-6 please encourage them to take up their school meal this Thursday and help us to help your children.
