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### Connecting conversations with your child

Would you like to connect more with your child and have better conversations? Would you like to find out more about what your child has been learning at school? Here are some top tips and prompts to help with chats at home.

Try asking them 2 or 3 of these questions each day to get them to open up and discuss their day with you:

- who made you smile today?
- who was kind to you today?
- who were you kind to today?
- · what made you laugh today?
- what is the funniest thing that you heard/saw today?
- what new things did you learn today?
- can you tell me 1 fact that you learnt today?
- what are you thankful about today?
- what is the hardest thing that you had to do today?

These prompts may encourage your child to open up and chat to you about their day. These questions require more than a 'yes' or 'no' answer but don't require too much from them either. Once they have started talking, ask more questions. Try to make it a daily habit - and make it fun!

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#### Message from Miss Higginson

Welcome back to the new school term, we hope you all had a good break. We would like to welcome all our new pupils who have started in nursery an across the school, we look forward to working with you and your child in the coming year. We also welcomed back Mrs Drew from maternity leave, and she is working within our EYFS team. Mrs Sullivan has started with us this term as our Assistant Head of School (KS2 team leader) alongside Mrs Budden. If you have any questions, please speak to your child's class teacher in the first instance.

Our children are proud to be at HPS and following our school uniform policy is important. All children must be wearing the correct uniform including on PE days. Shirts and shorts must be to the knee. We have some second hand jumpers in school, please just ask if you would like one.

Please can we remind you that break time snacks should be a piece of fresh fruit or vegetables. Drinks bottles for lesson times should contain tap water only.

The work on our roof continues with the scaffolding still being erected before the work on the roof can start. We would like to thank you for your patience and cooperation with the changes to the school site. Please could I remind parents who use the park entrance not to block the path so that children can enter in the morning, and nursery parents can leave the school site.

We are still collecting plastic chocolate tubs to be recycled and to help raise money for Dartmoor Zoo. All tubs need to be handed in to school by Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> January.

The school gates are opened at 8.45am and closed at 8.55am. The register is taken at 8.55am and if your child arrives after this they are late. It is important all children arrive at school on time.

As you will be aware from the news there are high cases of flu, COVID and scarlet fever circulating. The government is providing the following advice:

- If your child feels unwell and has a fever, they should stay at home until the fever has resolved and they feel better.
- Regularly washing hands and catching coughs and sneezes in tissues.
- Having the flu vaccination
- Please don't send your child to school if they are feeling unwell and have a temperature
