This week's assemblies:

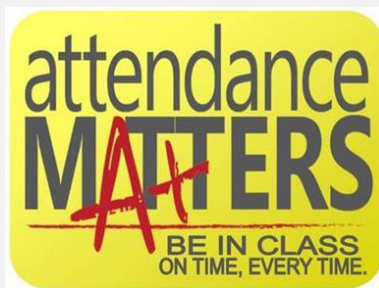
