Childcare Choices

Thousands of families could be saving money on their childcare costs, but some simply don't know what support they might be eligible for.

The <u>Childcare Choices website</u> brings together all the existing childcare offers in one place, so parents can get the help that fits their family. This could be through Tax-Free Childcare, 30 Hours Childcare, or Universal Credit Childcare. Some families might be eligible to use more than one childcare scheme together and get the most out of it.

Sleep study seeks children with SEND aged 5 to 11 years

Poor sleep is linked with poorer executive skills like attention and problem solving, which are important for regulating behaviour and paying attention in the classroom.
