

Communication and Language

Listening to a story and answering a simple question about it.
Retelling a story using own words, sequencing beginning, middle and ending.
Using talk to develop their ideas expanding their vocabulary.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Developing resilience and setting myself a goal- never give up, keep trying and to deal with set backs.
Understanding and participating in healthy practices eg, washing hands, eating fruit/veg and brushing teeth twice a day.

Physical Development

Fine motor- Developing finger strength, use pincer grip, control pencil to record lines, circles and forming letters correctly.
Gross motor- Developing climbing and jumping skills, developing balance and riding trikes, scooters and balance bikes.

Literacy

Nursery-RWI -Set 1 sounds- blending and segmenting, planned talk, developing pencil grip and forming letters.

Reception- RWI - Set 1 sounds including digraphs, blending and segmenting, retelling stories, reading and writing some common exception words, writing captions.
